

Explore from both surface and deep-sea perspectives—including the world's only Ocean Floor Elevator Cage, where Great Whites glide over the reef and sea grass just meters away. Legendary wildlife photographer Amos Nachoum will also be on board, offering hands-on coaching to help you capture these unforgettable moments in all their raw, natural power.

Whether you're a diver, photographer, or passionate adventurer, this expedition is your chance to witness Great Whites in their true habitat—alongside the pioneers who brought them into the global spotlight.



#### **MV RODNEY FOX**

Aboard the MV Rodney Fox vessel, you'll experience an unforgettable and thrilling adventure, with comfort and safety as top priorities. The vessel has been designed and equipped to ensure an enjoyable and secure journey as you explore the fascinating world of great white sharks.

The expedition vessel offers comfortable accommodations for guests, with a range of cabin options to suit different preferences. Most cabins are equipped with private ensuite bathrooms and air conditioning for a pleasant stay. The vessel also features cozy communal areas, including a spacious dining area where guests can enjoy delicious meals prepared by the onboard chef. Dietary requirements are taken into account to ensure everyone's needs are met.

The boat's spacious deck areas offer plenty of room for relaxation, socializing, and enjoying the stunning ocean views. It's also an excellent place for photography enthusiasts to set up their equipment and capture breathtaking images of the marine life, sunsets, and surrounding landscapes.





### THE DIVING

When it comes to the shark diving experience, Rodney Fox Expeditions provides topnotch safety gear and uses custom-built cages for underwater encounters. The knowledgeable crew, with years of experience in great white shark diving, is always on hand to provide expert guidance, ensuring guests have a safe and memorable encounter with these magnificent creatures.

The Rodney Fox organization offers two distinct cage options for diving encounters: the lower cage and the surface cage. Each cage is designed to accommodate four divers, providing ample space and comfort.

#### **SURFACE CAGE**

The surface cage holds four divers comfortably. You enter the steady, super-strong cage from the dive deck, and you are completely safe at all times. Then the fun, excitement and pure adrenalin rush of the Great White Shark experience comes to life. These magnificent animals are mesmerizing and majestic, effortlessly gliding around and below the cage.









### THE DIVING

#### **OCEAN FLOOR CAGE**

Our partner Rodney Fox Shark Expeditions is the <u>only company in the world</u> that has Ocean Floor Cage Diving. Anchored off the Neptune Islands, up to three guests with a Dive Professional descend approximately 66 feet (20 meters) into a world that will captivate and spell-bind.

Once divers in the lower cage are at ease, the dive masters will open the cage door, offering a clear and unobstructed view of the environment and the majestic sharks gliding gracefully above the seabed.






To ensure equal filming opportunities, the four divers in the lower cage will share the open-door experience, with two divers at a time capturing the breathtaking underwater world. Additionally, guests can look forward to a day spent diving with playful Australian seals and embarking on a quest to discover and photograph the elusive weedy and leafy sea dragons.





## **MEET YOUR GUIDES**



Amos Nachoum is a distinguished figure in wildlife and underwater photography, seamlessly combining exploration and artistry for over 45 years. His dedication to capturing the essence of marine life has garnered him prestigious accolades, including twice winning the BBC Wildlife Photographer of the Year in Animal Behavior and the Siena Photo Competition in 'Animals in Their Environment' category.



Rodney Fox survived a severe attack by a Great White Shark in 1963, which inspired him to build the world's first shark cage and begin cage diving expeditions to observe and study the creatures. He filmed the first-ever underwater footage of Great White Sharks, which gained international recognition and contributed to the industry of shark cage diving.



Rodney continued to run tours and make films until 1999, and his son, **Andrew Fox**, now carries on the family legacy as a world-renowned underwater photographer and advocate of Great White Sharks. Andrew is now a globally recognized authority on great white sharks and is often approached by the media for his balanced opinion on environmental issues, shark attacks, and shark culling.

### THINGS TO KNOW

#### TRIP ORGANIZER

Bringing an expedition like the Great White Shark Expedition to life takes a world-class team. That's why we've partnered with Amos Nachoum (Big Animals) and Rodney & Andrew Fox (Rodney Fox Shark Expeditions) to make this journey possible. The trip is organized and run by Big Animals.

#### **PAYMENT TERMS**

A non-refundable deposit of 40% is required to secure your booking and may be paid by major credit card (no credit card fees applied). The remaining balance is due 90 days before the tour starts and it's paid through bank transfer.

Upon receipt of your reservation deposit, you will receive a preparatory package with a receipt denoting your deposit paid and balance due date, trip confirmation, detailed itinerary, medical and liability release forms, trip insurance requirements, equipment list and other pre-trip information.

Balances are due 90 days prior to departure. Balances may be paid by bank transfer.

#### **CANCELLATIONS**

All requests for cancellation must be received in writing to Adventure Fix GO.

Cancellations received more than 90 days prior to the trip departure date means a loss of your deposit (40% of the trip cost). We encourage you to make the responsible choice – protect your investment with a reasonably-priced, comprehensive insurance policy. Once we have accepted your deposit and application, we will make non-refundable payments to secure your space with overseas vendors; consequently, all deposits on expeditions are also non-refundable, without exception.

In the event of cancellations made 61 - 90 calendar days (12:00am US Pacific Time) before the expeditions; start date, Big Animals LLC will charge a fee equal to 50% of the expeditions' full price.

Cancellations or modifications made within 60 calendar days before the expeditions; start date, Big Animals LLC will charge a fee equal to 100% of the expeditions; full price, without exception.

We strongly recommend that you obtain adequate trip cancellation insurance.

In order to join an expedition, you are required to carry trip, health, and dive insurance. This information as well as your passport photo will be requested after you place your deposit.

Dates and pricing are subject to change without prior notice due to weather conditions, animal behavior, and currency fluctuation.
